Kids Only Sleepover – Itinerary

Time	Activity	Comments
2.30pm - onwards	Group arrival	You will be met by the Safari Night Leader upon your arrival Briefing and safety talk (including outline of itinerary, rules and policies, and emergency procedures)
3.00pm	Zoo Trail	You will be split into groups for a daylight trail and, each group will have a guide with Zoo exercise work sheets to do while walking around the zoo.
5.00pm	Dinner	You will now have a BBQ dinner at the Old Elephant House. This will be prepared for you by the Safari Night team.
5.30pm	Setup	All hands on deck to setup the beds for the night
5.45pm	Games	Time to relax with some awesome Zoo Games
6.20pm	Safari walk	The entire group goes out together (lead by two or more Safari Leaders) on a torch-lit expedition to explore the Zoo after dark. Note: The specific route of the walk will be dependent on light and weather conditions
8.00pm	Watch family movie	Watch a DVD on the big screen at the Old Elephant House
9.30pm	Supper	It's the end of the night so a hot drink and biscuits will now be served
10.30pm	Lights out	It is important for animal welfare (and staff!) that lights and noise are out by 10.30pm. It is the responsibility of the Safari guide staff to keep the children indoors for the entire night (this is of paramount importance for their own safety)
7.00am	Wake up call	The group have this time to get themselves up and ready and pack away their personal belongings ready for departure
7.10am	Pack up	Mattresses and carpets need to go back into storage. Tables and chairs need to be set up for breakfast
7.30am	Breakfast	Time for cereal and toast at the Old Elephant House.
8.00am	Guided walk	After a quick breakfast clean up there will be a final guided tour around the Zoo
9.30am	Departure	Meet parent at the main entrance of the zoo in the court yard area We hope that you have had a wild time!
